Student Assessment Data: Elementary or middle school assessment results on the Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (MSTEP), high school assessment results on the MSTEP component of the Michigan Merit Exam (MME) and assessment results for students with disabilities on Michigan's Alternative Assessment Program (MI-Access). This information:

- provides achievement data for all four tested subjects (English Language Arts, mathematics, science and social studies) compared to targets for all students as well as subgroups of students
- helps parents understand achievement progress within schools and compare these to regional and state achievement

Accountability Scorecard: Detail Data and Status

This information:

- identifies teacher qualifications at district and school levels
- reports percentage of core academic classes taught by teachers not considered highly qualified to teach such classes
- identifies the school district's rating: from "red" (did not meet targets) to "green" (met targets)
- reports graduation and attendance rates
