What It Looks Like

10th grade	Students begin Early College by taking a college success strategies course at their local high school.
11-12th grades	Students take college classes at GCC, or specific CTE courses that offer college credit through the GOISD.
13th grade	Students complete their program of study at GCC

Students may begin Early College after their sophomore year. However, they must still take the college success strategies course. Depending on the program of study they choose, they may not finish it by the fifth year of high school. The student can then go on to complete their degree as a traditional college student.
